or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $$\rm NM\ 1/4\ SM\ 1/4\ as\ projected\ within\ Dixon\ DLC\ 41, Section\ 23, T265, R5M, WM; 60 feet South and 570 feet West from NE Corner, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section\ 23.$

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre.
