CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That STEPHEN D. WARNOCK

of Route 2, Box 1275, Bandon , State of Oregon 97411 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring Creek

a tributary of Coquille River for the purpose of harvesting cranberries

under Permit No. 31526 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 23, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.58 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion, NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 20, T28S, R14W, WM, 840 feet South and 440 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner, Section 20

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 20, T28S, R14W, WM, 605 feet South and 50 feet East from N 1/4 Corner, Section 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Harvesting cranberries on 3.4 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 17
Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 22, 1970 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 36501, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
