## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

W.S. AND R.M. MOUNT

of Route 1, Box 280 A, Myrtle Creek , State of Oregon 97457 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Salt Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.1 acre, supplemental irrigation of 0.3 acre and supplemental domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 34191 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 27, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cfs for irrigation and 0.01 cfs for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 28, T3C5, R2W, WW; 3410 feet North and 130 feet East from SE Corner of the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toon—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre—feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 44055, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT changed from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 8, 1985, and describes the balance of the right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of DRS  $\pm40.610$  pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
