This is to certify, That

c/O Mary Gaulke of Star Route, Box 60, Canyonville . State of Oregon 97417 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 1.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 41100 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

September 13, 1976 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to a mount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Thorn DLC 44, Section 8, T3OS, R4W, WM; 2610 feet North and 320 feet West from SE Corner, Section 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to $\verb"one-eightieth" of one cubic foot per second per$

acre. or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
