## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** MILLION DITCH USERS

c/o Harry A. Skerry, Jr., Attorney at Law  
 of 76 North Pioneer Street, Ashland, Oregon 97520, has  
 a right to the use of the waters of Ashland Creek

a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of  
 irrigation of 12.894 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
 Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
 the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page ; that the priority of the  
 right thereby confirmed dates from 1856

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.196 cubic foot  
 per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 9, T39S, R1E, WM;  
 Million Ditch.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
 follows:

2.28 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4  
 8.3 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4  
 2.314 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4  
 Section 4  
 Township 39 South, Range 1 East, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the  
 prior certificate recorded at page 45508, Volume 38, State Record of Water  
 Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water  
 Resources Director entered on March 25, 1985, approving transfer application  
 No. 5580.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of  
 the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to  
 forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
 The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
 use herein described.
