This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 45508, Volume 38, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 25, 1985, approving transfer application No. 5580.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forefeiture or abandomment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
