CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That CHARLES D. AND JANE C. WAVRA

of 8167 Oak Lane, Mt. Angel, State of Oregon 97362, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Little Pudding River for the purpose of irrigation of 11.2 acres

under Permit No. G-6909 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 9, 1976

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 11, T8S, R2W, WM; 1750 feet South and 950 feet West from SW Corner, Waldo DLC 41.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.7 acres Lot 2 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4)
 3.7 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within Goodman DLC 42
 3.8 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Goodman DLC 42
 Section 14
 Township 8 South, Range 2 West, WM

This certificate is issued so as to correctly describe the place of use and point of appropriation and supersedes Certificate of Water Right recorded at page 49874, Volume 43, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
