## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This is to certify, That EARL CLAMPETT

of Route 1, Box 2740, Coquille ,State of Oregon 97423 ,has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring – stream

a tributary of Coquille River for the purpose of domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn, and noncommercial garden and stock use under Permit No. 47775 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 8, 1983

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cfs for domestic and 0.005 cfs for stack

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/A NW 1/A, Section 26, T285, R14W, WM; 305 feet South from North 1/4 Corner, Section 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Stock - SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23

Domestic and Stock - NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 26 Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
