CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That ANDREW S. SMITH

of 2301 Lone Rock Road, Glide, State of Oregon 97443, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Britt Creek

a tributary of North Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 10.0 acres

under Permit No. 9538 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 27, 1930 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 10, T26S, R3W, WM

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 10, T26S, R3W, WM; 1415 feet North and 75 feet West from S 1/4 Corner, Section 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 10
Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 25, 1979, and together with special order recorded at page 213, Volume 39, supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 42161, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
