CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That LORETTA DWENS

c/o H.A. Broughton of 14615 Water Gap Road, Williams, State of Oregon 97544, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Pleasant Creek

a tributary of Evans Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 4.3 acres

under Permit No. 9802 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 20, 1930 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion, SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 33, T34S, R4W, WM; 780 feet North and 380 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 33 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 34, T34S, R4W, WM, 1180 feet North and 200 feet East from SW Corner, Section 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.3 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 34 Township 34 South, Range 4 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 49184, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 25, 1985, approving transfer application No. 5590.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
