CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That DAVID D. AND MARVEENE A. DUMMER

of General Delivery, Joseph, State of Oregon 97846, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Wallowa River and D.D.D. Pond constructed under Permit No. R-5980

a tributary of Grand Ronde River for the purpose of wildlife and fish culture

under Permit No. 36845 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

April 7, 1972 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 31, T2S, R45E, WM, (Wrenn Dobbin Ditch) - 550 feet South and 800 feet West from NE Corner, Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 20
Township 2 South, Range 45 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
