## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That                  GEORGE E. WOOD

of Route 1, Box 163, Wallowa                  , State of          Oregon 97885          , has  
a right to the use of the waters of          South Fork Wallowa (Lostine) River

a tributary of          Wallowa River                  for the purpose of  
irrigation of 24.0 acres and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Wallowa          County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume          5          , at page 144          ; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1896

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.5 acre-feet per  
acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31 of each year, and  
thereafter not to exceed 1 acre-foot per acre during the entire remainder of  
the irrigation season; if available at the original point of diversion in the  
SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 15, T1S, R43E, WM; Wood-Boatman Ditch - North 67 \*

The point of diversion is located in the          NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 22, T1S, R43E, WM,  
Lostine Ditch - 830 feet South and 2700 feet East from the NW Corner,  
Section 22.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

\*degrees, East, 2540 feet from the SW Corner, Section 15.

24.0 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4  
Section 10  
Township 1 South, Range 43 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved  
by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 17, 1977 and  
together with certificates of water right recorded at page 44914, Volume 36,  
and page 53404, Volume 48, State Record of Water Right Certificates,  
supersedes Certificate 2940.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of  
the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to  
forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
