CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That ALBERT G. WOOSLEY

of Route 1, Box 4095, Coquille, State of Oregon 97423, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of Pulaski Creek for the purpose of stock and domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area under Permit No. 40925 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 17, 1976 for 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic and October 18, 1976* that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cfs, being 0.01 cfs for each use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 14, T28S, R13W, WM; 1720 feet South and 2000 feet West from NE Corner, Section 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

*for 0.01 cfs for stock

SW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 14
Township 28 South, Range 13 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
