## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That

of 1419 Valley View Drive, Roseburg , State of Oregon 97470 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

Umpqua River a tributary of irrigation of 3.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 43481 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 26, 1978

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of SW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Leiser diversion is located in the DLC 53, Section 13, T27S, R6W, WM; 1170 feet North and 700 feet East from SW Corner, Section 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per existing for the same lands, shall be limited to or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for

each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 3.3 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Leiser DLC 53 Section 13 Township 27 South, Range 6 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein prior to this right. Water Resources Commission WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed
