## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This is to certify, That** DENNIS E. AND ESTELLE McCAFFERTY  
FOR DESCHUTES NATIONAL FOREST

of 102 Deadmond Ferry Road, Springfield, State of Oregon 97477, has made  
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of  
Metolius River

a tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of  
domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 47949 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in  
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from  
July 26, 1983

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is  
limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.00048 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of  
diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 15, T13S, R9E, WM;  
230 feet North and 610 feet West from SE Corner of the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section  
15

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right  
existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per  
acre.

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4  
Section 15  
Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM

Land upon which water is used more explicitly described as  
Lot 15, Tract C, Camp Sherman Summer Homes

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein  
described and is subject to minimum flows established by the ~~Water Resources Commission~~ with an effective date  
prior to this right.
