CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That ERNEST TUCKER LIVINGSTONE

of 2577 NW Westover Road, Portland, State of Oregon 97210, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Metolius River

a tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.3 acre lawn and noncommercial garden

under Permit No. 47960 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 29, 1983

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 10, T13S, R9E, WM; 680 feet North and 330 feet East from the SW Corner of the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-sixtieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 0.3 acre NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 10 Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM

Land upon which water is used more explicitly described as Lot 4, Tract E, Camp Sherman Summer Homes

In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a clerical error was inadvertently made in not including the duty of water. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water of one-sixtieth cubic foot per second per acre and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year is being added, in keeping with the customary policy and determination of this office of the proper maximum limits.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR with an effective date prior to this right.
