## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This is to certify, That** CALVIN S. AND DOLA B. LUSCOMBE

of 385 Luscombe Drive, Coos Bay, State of Oregon 97420, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of Noble Creek (Isthmus Slough) for the purpose of domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 42454 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 9, 1977 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 11, T27S, R13W, WM; 1321.22 feet South and 1667.40 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4  
Section 2  
Township 27 South, Range 13 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Board with an effective date prior to this right.
