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of MT. Angel State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Peterson Creek, a tributary of Crooked River,

for the purpose of the irrigation of forty acres of land, and domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for rook

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Example of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 449; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1892.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, and one-half cubic foot per second for irrigation, from July 1st to September 15th of each year. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

10 scres in the SW2 of NE2; 30 acres in the SE2 of NT2; Section Thirteen (13), Township Fourteen (14) South Range Twenty-one (21) East of Willamette Meridian, in Grook County, Oregon.
