CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That COOS BAY TIMBER COMPANY

of Coos Bay, State of Oregon 97420, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Coquille River and reservoir constructed under Permit R-1073

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of maintenance of pond for storing and sorting logs

under Permit No. 19786 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 21, 1950 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.10 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 24, T28S, R13W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 22794, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on September 16, 1985, approving Transfer Application 5662.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
