of 2696 Southwest Bentwood Drive, Redmond, State of Oregon 97756, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
five wells

a tributary of Deep Canyon Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 303.4 acres and supplemental irrigation of 90.0 acres

under Permit No. G-7360 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
December 15, 1976

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is
limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

4.915 cubic feet per second, being 0.15 cfs from Well 3, 0.003 cfs from Well 5,
0.002 cfs from Well 6, 2.71 cfs from Well 8 and 2.05 cfs from Well 4.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is
located in the

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4,
Section 20, T14S, R12E, WM; Well 4 - 1050 feet North and 170 feet East from SW
Corner, Section 20; Well 5 - 300 feet South and 40 feet West; Well 6 - 1260
feet South and 40 feet West; Well 8 - 2350 feet South and 1060 feet West all
from the NE Corner, Section 20, NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 35, T14S, R11E, WM;*

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right
existing for the same lands, shall be limited to

one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season of each year

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:
