CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, *That*US FOREST SERVICE,
ROGUE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST

of PO Box 520, Medford, Oregon 97501, has
a right to the use of the waters of Squaw Creek and Squaw Lake Reservoir

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of
recreation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1876

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.60 cubic foot
per second, if available at the original point of diversion, Thurman and
Collins Ditch.

The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 2, T41S, R3W, WM; 790
feet South and 2440 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 2.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
NE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 2
Township 41 South, Range 3 West, WM

SE 1/4
Section 35
Township 40 South, Range 3 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use, place of use, and point
of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered
May 8, 1980, and together with certificate of water right recorded at
page 49685, Volume 43, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes
Certificate 16450.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of
the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to
forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
