CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ALAN T. BAAS

of P.O. BOX 297, Wolf Creek, State of Oregon 97497, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of French Gulch

a tributary of Wolf Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 3.7 acres

under Permit No. 4060 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 24, 1919

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second if available at the original point of diversion SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 26, T33S, R6W, WM; 1980 feet South and 165 feet East from NW Corner, Section 26.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 26, T33S, T6W, WM; 450 feet South and 425 feet East from NW corner, Section 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 12, 1975, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 43770, Volume 35 State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes Certificate 2887.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
