CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That WILLIAM R. GAAR

of 251 Wilderville Lane, Grants Pass, State of Oregon 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Slate Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 7.0 acres

under Permit No. 16596 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 19, 1945 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 1, T37S, R7W, WM; 300 feet South and 1200 feet West from E 1/4 Corner, Section 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
2.0 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 1
Township 37 South, Range 7 West, WM

This certificate is issued so as to correctly describe the date of priority and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 53343, Volume 48, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Rights Repeal Act with an effective date prior to this right.
