This Is to Certify, That

of 3000 Dick George Road, Cave Junction, State of Oregon 97523 has
a right to the use of the waters of Althouse Creek

a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of
irrigation of 8.9 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 427; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1898

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic foot
per second, if available at the original point of diversion, NE 1/4 NW 1/4,
Section 18, T40S, R7W, W4; 670 feet South and 1800 feet East from the NW
Corner of Section 18.

The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 18, T40S, R7W, W4;
860 feet South and 2090 feet East, from NW Corner of Section 18.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 18, 1973 and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 44002, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes Certificate 2935.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
