## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This is to certify, That** B.L. DAVIS RANCH, INC.

of Box 159, Adams, State of Oregon 97810, has made  
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of  
a well

a tributary of Wildhorse Creek for the purpose of  
irrigation of 41.6 acres

under Permit No. G-3278 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in  
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from  
May 3, 1966  
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is  
limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.52 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is  
located in the Lot 3 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 3, T3N, R34E, WM; 740  
feet South and 1650 feet East from NW Corner, Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right  
existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited  
to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated  
during the irrigation season of each year

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows: 4.0 acres Lot 4 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4)  
8.8 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4  
Section 2  
28.8 acres Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4)  
Section 3  
Township 3 North, Range 34 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an  
order of the Water Resources Director entered May 24, 1985 and also describes  
the portions of the prior certificate NOT modified by the provisions of said  
order, supersedes Certificate 40895.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of  
the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to  
forfeiture or abandonment.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein  
described.
