CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. DONALD CAPON

of Route 1, Kimberly, State of Oregon 97848, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Fork John Day River

a tributary of John Day River (Columbia River) for the purpose of irrigation of 17.0 acres

under Permit No. 3854 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 12, 1918

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 3, T9S, R27E, WM; Allen Ditch - North 49 degrees East, 3814 feet from the SW Corner, Section 3

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 3, SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 4, T9S, R27E, WM; 1 - 2030 feet North and 2270 feet East, 2 - 950 feet North and 1200 feet East, 3 - 370 feet North and 1210 feet West, all from the SW Corner, Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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4.3 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4
2.0 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4
6.0 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 3
4.7 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 4
Township 9 South, Range 27 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 1, 1983 and together with certificates of water right recorded at page 51969, Volume 46 and page 53671, Volume 48, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes Certificate 39363.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
