CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That COOS COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION DEPT. of Room 214, Coos County Courthouse, Coquille, State of Oregon 97423, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to store the waters of

South Fork of Coquille River and an unnamed stream (Morris Creek), a tributary of Coquille River, appropriated under Permits 24826 and 24827

recreation for the purposes of

under Reservoir Permit No. R-2007, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

February 11, 1955

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 108.0 acre feet.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 22, 1979, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 26063, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
