CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of PO Box 172, North Powder , State of Oregon 97867 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Powder River
a tributary of Snake River for the purpose irrigation of 34.0 acres
under Permit No. 42792 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 20, 1977
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.85 cubic foot per second
or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 1, T7S, R39E, WM 30 feet North and 1510 feet West from the Center Quarter Corner, Section 1.
The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second peacre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year
and sho conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right appurtenant, is as follows:
30.0 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 4.0 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 25 Township 6 South, Range 39 East, WM
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of us herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with a effective date prior to this right.
