CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That JEANETTE DAY

of 1260 Sterling Creek Rd., Jacksonville, State of Oregon 97530, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Poorman's Creek

a tributary of Forest Creek (Applegate River) for the purpose of irrigation of 0.4 acre

under Permit No. 37683 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

March 14, 1973 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 7, T38S, R2W, WM; 240 feet South and 780 feet East from the Center of Section 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 acre NW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 7
Township 38 South, Range 2 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
