CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That LEO J. LYMP

c/o Gerda R. Lymp
of PO Box 207, Wemme, State of Oregon 97067, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
Gerda Fork Lymp Creek and Dates Fork Lymp Creek, Welches Creek, Lymp Creek,
and Reservoir No. 2 constructed under Permit R-6129
a tributary of Salmon River for the purpose of
domestic use for one family and fish culture

under Permit No. 37865 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
July 11, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is
limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.003 cfs from Gerda Fork Lymp Creek and
0.002 cfs from Dates Fork Lymp Creek for domestic use and 0.005 cfs from Lymp
Creek and Reservoir 2 and 0.005 cfs from Welches Creek for fish culture

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of
diversion is located in the

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 5, NW 1/4 NE 1/4,
Section 8, T3S, R7E, WM; Diversion 1 - 2940 feet South and 270 feet East;
Diversion 2 - 2330 feet South and 130 feet East; Reservoir 1 - 1950 feet South
and 590 feet East; Reservoir 2 - 1600 feet South and 630 feet East;
Diversion 3 - 2330 feet South and 400 feet East, all from Center of Section 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right
existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per
acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 5
Township 3 South, Range 7 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an
effective date prior to this right.
