CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That SILVER LAKE IRRIGATION DISTRICT ZX RANCH

of c/o Lawrence Iverson, Silver Lake, State of Oregon 97638, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Thompson Valley Reservoir, constructed under Permits R-680 and R-4461

a tributary of Silver Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 40.0 acres

under Permit No. 46368 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 21, 1981 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 120 acre-feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 17, T30S, R14E, WM; 600 feet North and 1700 feet East from SW Corner, Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from Thompson Valley Reservoir,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

24.8 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4
15.2 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 27
Township 28 South, Range 14 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
