CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That MILBURN ZIEGLER

of Route 1, Box 89C, Newberg, State of OR 97132, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two springs

a tributary of Heaton Creek for the purpose of domestic use for three families

under Permit No. 43570 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 18, 1978 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 29, T2S, R2W, WM; Spring 1 - 230 feet North and 110 feet East; Spring 2 - 20 feet North and 210 feet East, both from SW corner NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 20
NE 1/4 NE 1/4
NW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 29
Township 2 South, Range 2 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
