for the purpose of the irrigation of 112 acres of land, and domestic and stock use.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State water water water water water by the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 449; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1888,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an unmount netually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, and 1.4 cubic feet per second for irrigation, the total quantity being limited to four acre feet per acre during each year. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

5 acres in the SW¹₄ of NE¹₄; 18 acres in the NE¹₂ of NW¹₄; 8 acres in the NW¹₄ of NW¹₄; 40 acres in the SW¹₄ of NW¹₄; 25 acres in the SE¹₂ of NW¹₄; 16 acres in the NW¹₄ of SW¹₂; Section Four (4) Township Fifteen (15) South Range Seventeen (17) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
