## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This is to certify, That** FRANKLIN H. BARNTHOUSE

of 7434 Henderer Rd., Elkton, State of Oregon 97436, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring and an unnamed stream

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 1.0 acre

under Permit No. 38099 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 2, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.01 cubic foot per second from the unnamed spring when available with any deficiency to be made up by appropriation from the unnamed stream provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed 0.01 cfs

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 10 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 20 (spring), SE 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected within DLC 46, Section 17 (stream), T22S, R8W, WM; 350 feet South and 1900 feet West; 950 feet North and 500 feet West, both from SE Corner, Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.8 acre SE 1/4 SE 1/4  
Section 17  
0.2 acre NE 1/4 NE 1/4  
Section 20  
both as projected within Gardner DLC 51  
Township 22 South, Range 8 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
