CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**This is to certify, That** JOHN J. SPETTER

of 1510 E. F. Road, Williams, State of Oregon 97544, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Clapboard Gulch and reservoir constructed under permit No. R-1782

a tributary of East Fork Williams Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 6.8 acres

under Permit No. 43012 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 22, 1978 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 (Gulch), NW 1/4 NE 1/4 (Reservoir), Section 10, T39S, R5W, WM; 2030 feet South and 350 feet East, 150 feet South and 800 feet West, both from the NE Corner NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-1782

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.6 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 3

5.2 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 10
Township 39 South, Range 5 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
