## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That JOHN MULHOLLAND
of Route 3, Box 285 B, Gaston , State of OR 97119 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4519
a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of stock and use in a dairy barn
under Permit No. 43571 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 21, 1978
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second
or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected within Hineman DLC 59, Section 31, T1S, R4W, WM; 350 feet North and 310 feet East from the SW corner of Hineman DLC 59.
The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre, this right is limited to use during the period of October through April 30 of each year
and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.  A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
SE 1/4 SE 1/4 As projected within Hineman DLC 59 Section 31 Township 1 South, Range 4 West, WM
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
