CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That WILLIAM AND KATHLEEN MATHIS

of 14034 NE Stag Hollow Rd, Yamhill, State of Oregon 97148, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of Stag Hollow Creek (North Yamhill River) for the purpose of stock

under Permit No. 39854 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 25, 1975

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected within Roberts DLC 49, Section 12, T3S, R4W, WM; South 87 degrees 57 minutes East 2788.44 feet from the NW corner of Roberts DLC 49.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4
As projected within Roberts DLC 49
Section 12
Township 3 South, Range 4 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
