CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That DEPARTMENT OF FISH and WILDLIFE

of 506 SW Mill Street, Portland, State of OR 97201, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Elk River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of fish hatchery

under Permit No. 35711 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 26, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 20.0 cubic feet per second, if available at the original point of diversion, Lot 2 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), Section 6, T33S, R14W, WM; 639 feet North and 600 feet East from S 1/4 Corner Section 6

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), Section 6, T33S, R14W, WM; 200 feet North and 1210 feet East from S 1/4 Corner, Section 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 2 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4)
Section 6
Township 33 South, Range 14 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 5, 1976 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 42613, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
