## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That JERRY W. and CATHERINE A. EVITTS

of 5055 Highway 66, Ashland, State of Oregon 97520, has  
a right to the use of the waters of  
Neil Creek

a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of  
irrigation of 4.5 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1854

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.055 cubic foot  
per second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Hiatt DLC 42,  
Section 19, T39S, R2E, WM; Taylor Ditch - 330 feet South and 65 feet West from  
SW Corner, DLC 43.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

4.5 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Taylor DLC 41  
Section 19  
Township 39 South, Range 2 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved  
by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 16, 1976, and  
together with certificates of water right recorded at page 37488, Volume 29,  
and page 43754, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, super-  
sedes Certificate 36141.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the  
water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture  
or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
