CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, ThatGLEN & LELA PLUMLEE
MICHAEL & ELSIE ROLLER

of PO Box 327, Selma, State of Oregon 97538, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
Deer Creek

a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of
irrigation of 10.3 acres

under Permit No. 4294 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
October 18, 1919

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is
limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.13 cubic feet per second, if available at the original point of diversion;
NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 11, T38S, R8W, WM; 1025 feet South and 35 feet East
from Center Quarter Corner Section 11

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of
diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4. Section 11, T38S, R8W, WM;
No. 1 - 750 feet South and 250 feet West, No. 2 - 720 feet South and 445 feet
West both from Center Quarter Corner Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right
existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per
acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be
further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for
each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

10.3 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 11
Township 38 South, Range 8 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved
by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 5, 1978 and
together with certificate of water right recorded at page 46574, Volume 39,
State Record of Water Right Certificates, supercedes certificate 3907.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of
the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to
forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an
effective date prior to this right.
