CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one—half acre in area

under Permit No. 36786 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 28, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.01 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 8, T37S, R9W, WM; 420 feet South and 360 feet East from Center 1/4 Corner, Section 8.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 8, T37S, R9W, WM; 420 feet South and 360 feet East from Center 1/4 Corner, Section 8; 680 North and 960 feet East from Corner 3, H.E.S. 201.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm an additional point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 21, 1981, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 50285, Volume 44, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
