that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 8, T2N, R33E, WM; 650 feet North and 510 feet East from Center, Section 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second existing for the same lands, shall be limited to per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
