CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

MARVIN D. & MARY L. CROPP

of PO Box 172, North Powder, State of OR 97867, has a right to the use of the waters of Powder River

a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of irrigation of 37.7 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1886

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40th of one cubic foot per second per acre

The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 1, T7S, R39E, WM; 30 feet North and 1510 feet West from the Center 1/4 corner Section 1 (Travillion - Koester Ditch)

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.3 acre NE 1/4 NE 1/4
1.6 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4
5.0 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4
13.6 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4
1.4 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
13.3 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4
2.5 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4

Section 25
Township 6 South, Range 39 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 18, 1977, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 45022, Volume 37, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 4290.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
