## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** V. A. GAWITH

of Route 4, Box 158, Milton-Freewater, State of Oregon 97862, has  
a right to the use of the waters of  
Ford Branch Little Walla Walla River

a tributary of Walla Walla River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 5.39 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1890 for 3.39 acres and 1900 for 2.0 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre, if available at the original point of diversion in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, T6N, R35E, WM; Morris Ditch - 50 feet North and 1295 feet West from South Quarter Corner, Section 26.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, T6N, R35E, WM; 1330 feet North and 1060 feet East from SW Corner, Section 26.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.39 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 26  
Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on February 16, 1972, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 38659, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes Certificate 12849.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
