## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** *That* JOHN LEBER

of Route 2, Box 172, Milton-Freewater, State of Oregon 97862, has  
a right to the use of the waters of  
South Branch Mud Creek

a tributary of Walla Walla River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 13.0 acres from April 1 to October 1 of each year

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 117; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1883

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per  
second, if available at the original point of diversion in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 20,  
T6N, R35E, WM; 340 feet North and 50 feet West from SE Corner, SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
Section 20.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 20, T6N, R35E, WM; 1660 feet  
North and 2000 feet East from SW Corner, Section 20.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

13.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 20  
Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by  
an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 15, 1967, and  
together with certificate of water right recorded at page 48485, Volume 42,  
State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes Certificate 38.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the  
water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture  
or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
