CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That JAMES GEORGE MAIN

of P. O. Box 1374, Roseburg, State of OR 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, unnamed stream, and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-6267 a tributary of Lookingglass Creek for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 0.9 acre

under Permit No. 39159 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 7, 1974 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second; being 0.005 cfs from the spring for domestic and 0.01 cfs from the unnamed stream and reservoir for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 32, T27S, R7W, WM; unnamed stream and reservoir: 400 feet North and 1080 feet East; spring: 370 feet North and 1135 feet East, both from S 1/4 Corner, Section 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-6267

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.9 acre SW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 32
Township 27 South, Range 7 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
