CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That JAMES E. OWEN

of Box 17, Weaver Road, Myrtle Creek, State of Oregon 97457, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring, an unnamed stream and South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 10.0 acres

under Permit No. 39408 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 4, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cfs from the spring for domestic, 0.115 cfs from the unnamed stream with any deficiency in the unnamed stream made up by diversion from South Umpqua River, and 0.01 cfs from South Umpqua River for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), (spring and unnamed stream), SW 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected within Weaver DLC 39, (South Umpqua River), Section 6, T30S, R5W, WM; spring- 100 feet South and 380 feet East; stream- 300 feet South and 450 feet East; river- 1840 feet South and 500 feet East, all from North 1/4 Corner, Section 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
