that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.56 cubic foot per second:

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtuant (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: 15 acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NEZNEZ), of Section Thirty-six (36); 10 acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SEZSEZ), of Section Twenty-five (25); Township Ten South, Range Thirty-nine East, W. M., 12 acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SWZSWZ) of Section Thirty (30); and 8 acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SWZNWZ) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Ten South, Range Forty East of the Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon, being a total of 45 acres.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
