CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OHMART AND CALABA

of 692 High Street N.E., Salem, State of Oregon 97301, has
a right to the use of the waters of North Santiam River

a tributary of Santiam River for the purpose of
irrigation of 39.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Marion County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 18, at page 437; that the priority of the right
thereby confirmed dates from May 14, 1909

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.49 cubic foot
per second.

NOTE: To compensate for losses between the point of diversion to the place of
use, an additional amount not exceeding ten percent is allowed.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4) Section 11, T9S, R1W,
WM being 1800 feet South and 2830 feet East from W 1/4 corner Section 11.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

6.1 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Houxhurst DLC 83
10.0 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Durbin DLC 82
0.2 acre SE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Durbin DLC 82
0.1 acre SE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Houxhurst DLC 83
0.7 acre NE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Durbin DLC 82
2.4 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Munkers DLC 39
12.0 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Munkers DLC 39
7.5 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Durbin DLC 82
Section 31
Township 7 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein
described.
