and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Marion County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 18, at page 437; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from May 14, 1909

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an 0.95 cubic foot amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed per second.

To compensate for losses between the point of diversion to the place of use, an additional amount not exceeding ten percent is allowed.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4) Section 11, T9S, R1W, WM being 1800 feet South and 2830 feet East from W 1/4 corner Section 11.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
